Course content Master's thesis is an independent theoretical and research work of students in the field of hearing disability. A student chooses a mentor out of teachers conducting courses at the module. In agreement with the chosen mentor, a student specifies a topic within the field of academic expertise and prepares a research project. The thesis is in written form and contains the following parts: introductory theoretical framework, research problem, research aims and objectives, hypotheses, methodology, research results, discussion, conclusion and literature. Master's thesis is defended publicly.
