Aim: is to familiarize students with the process of rehabilitation of deaf and hard of hearing children at an early age, as well as the independent creation of individual rehabilitation programs.

Course outcome: is that students are able to independently organize and realize the rehabilitation of listening and speaking deaf and hard of hearing children at an early age in the future work.

Course content

Lectures: defining the theoretical concept of rehabilitation-habilitation of deaf and early childhood children, principles, phases and models of re-habilitation, early diagnosis of children, models of amplification, development of verbal and non-verbal communication, development of suprasegmental structures, articulation, speech comprehension and active vocabulary. The role of the family in the rehabilitation process and advisory work with parents. Stimulating the psychomotor development of deaf and hard of hearing children in early-age.

Practical Exercises: Mastering techniques of early-age audiometry, fitting and adaptation to hearing aids and cochlear implants, engaging in the rehabilitation process, exercising independently.
